BIKER BOY was four wide in second flight, came in slightly entering the stretch and was no match. WHISTLE PIG saved ground and failed to menace. M J'S ENCHANTEUR was off slowest and then was hustled up inside, set the pace and then tired. PREMIUM WINE raced wide while just off the pace and tired. EUROEARS duled two wide, steadied near the quarter pole while retreating.
