Footnotes

CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE rated in good position widest, came through the turn six wide, dug in from the top of the stretch to reach the lead just inside the sixteenth pole and inched clear toward the wire. LITTLE NICK lacked early speed inside, angled outward through the turn, rallied widest into the stretch and had a strong finish for place. MR. NIGHTLINGER rated a pressured pace inside, contested a slim disadvantage from the head of the lane, recovered a short brief lead a sixteenth away, yielded to the winner was then outfinished for place. BLUE SAILOR pressured the pace two deep, edged ahead to contest the turn, dueled with the advantage from the top of the stretch, bore out while relenting a sixteenth from the wire and weakened from that point. CARDASHI chased the pace outside, was pinched back approaching the turn, recovered stride in the stretch and finished well outside. CUSTOM FOR CARLOS steadied slightly early, chased the pace in mid track, saved ground while taking aim through the turn, dug in a close factor to the sixteenth pole, was shuffled back from there and finished evenly. TRUE TO TRADITION chased the pace from the two path, was pinched back past the eighth pole and leveled off from there. AWAKINO CAT showed no speed two deep, angled out looking for room through the turn then leveled off in the lane. NATURAL SEVEN lacked room through most of the backstretch, continued giving chase while in tight on the turn, checked at the flanks of True To Tradition near the sixteenth pole and lost all chance. COOPER COUNTY chased the pace from the inside, checked on the rail into the turn and couldn't regain momentum. TRUST OR BUST chased the pace from the inside and was pinched back on the rail approaching the turn.
