GEM'S WAGER saved ground, split rivals in the stretch and was just up. BALANZA raced outside and just off the pace, challenged in deep stretch and just miss. TRAUMATIC vied for command two wide, steadied briefly between foes in deep stretch. TEDDY'S GIRL raced between foes and came up empty. SUGAH SUGAH failed to menace. CHEPPER vied for command inside, tired. FLAME CATCHER raced between foes, tired badly.
