ALL NIGHT REBEL was outrun early, moved up three wide near the far turn then drew clear to the finish. CALDERA PEAK was outrun early, rallied on the final turn then made a gradual late gain. JET AWAY JANE trailed early then closed well too late. GIOVANNA GOLD moved to the front near the far turn then yielded through the stretch. JOYFUL JACKIE raced off the pace inside and lacked a rally. LITTLE POLISH WOLF raced far back then rallied mildly. TUFF PARTNERS was close up early, angled inside after a half then flattened out. BONANZA JELLYBEAN raced wide and never threatened. FESTIVAL QUEEN set the pace to near the far turn then stopped. MANUKAI was close up early then gave way readily. STAGE ANTHEM was always far back in a dull effort.
