BOOTLEG FLYER raced outside while just off the pace, challenged but then was no match. ANDREW L vied for command well off the rail and then weakened. SURPRISE STORM raced wide and had no rally. BIGSTORMRISING broke slowly. EXCEPTIONAL HONOR failed to menace. SUNSHINE SATURDAY vied for command well off the rail and faltered. BECCA'S BEST raced wide. CERTAIN SECRET, wide, failed to menace. NIKI HOTWHEELS showed little.
