RED SEVEN vied for the lead to the far turn then gradually increased her margin under steady handling. SCILLY four wide early, rallied then lugged in bumping rival in the final sixteenth. ROYAL PROBE prompted the pace outside and was bumped late dueling for the place. KENTUCKY JUSTICE saved ground throughout and never menaced. SILVERROD'S KATE broke sluggishly and passed rivals while no factor. EXHILARATED trailed to the stretch then passed fading rivals. COUNTRY PRIZE raced inside early, drifted out and was never a factor. RUNNING HOME was far back throughout. MEL'S TURN bid close up three wide early then gave way readily.
