SIR DAVE was reserved early, angled five wide rallying into the lane and was up in time under strong handling. SEASTATE stalked the pacesetter, bid to the front in the stretch, moved clear but was caught in the final sixteenth. QUICK TO CHARM saved ground throughout, trailed early then found his best stride too late. ANEWDAY raced off the pace three wide and rallied mildly. SNOW FOX placed inside and was outrun early, angled out into the stretch with a mild bid. BRAVE TIGER raced outside and lacked a rally. GLOBAL WINDS set a clear pace to the final turn then came up empty. BEAN pursued the pace outside to the final turn then weakened. CRYPTOGRAM saved ground and gradually retreated. SPEAKTHRUTHEBRIDLE saved ground and faltered.
