ORAGE D'HIVER set the pace inside, shook loose to be well clear in mid stretch, began to shorten stride and lasted. SUNNY STRIKE was just off rail racing in closest pursuit, fell back slightly in mid stretch, came back and just missed. CHORDS OF FAME was off slowly and then outrun early, saved ground to the stretch, drifted out through the stretch and rallied. SUN KISS saved ground just off the early pace, had no rally. MAKE MISCHIEF failed to menace. LOOSE LEOTARD raced out from rail, and just off the pace, tired. KRISTINA'S ANSWER failed to menace. GOT LUCK failed to threaten. COURT SENSE raced wide, tired.
