Non-winners of an unrestricted stakes at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 3 lbs; of \$30,000 twice at a mile or over in 2010, 5 lbs; of \$30,000 at any distance in 2010, 9 lbs. (Maiden, claiming or starter races not considered.) Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing on Monday, September 13, 2010. Nominations closed Saturday, September 4, 2010 with 13. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

VIOLON SACRE was rank while taking under a stout hold in the opening furlong, raced inside and continued under a snug hold, bided his time waiting for racing room on the final turn and in early stretch, eased to the outside with a furlong to run, quickly took command and edged away. RAHY'S ATTORNEY vied for command two wide, shook loose to be clear mid stretch but then couldn't hold off winner. WAR HOOT was two wide, steadied briefly looking for racing room near the quarter pole, found racing room but then weakened. PICK SIX was three wide and never far, challenged after a half and then fell back. JUST AS WELL raced wide while never far back, came up empty. SUDDEN WAR (ARG) bumped with foe leaving gate, dueled inside and then gave way. POLKA AT NIGHT bumped with foe leaving gate, was well placed and then tired.
