Footnotes

PRINCESS CECILIA stalked the pace inside, assumed control near the three eighths pole, contested the rail through the turn and dug in under steady encouragement to maintain. SEABROOK LADY stalked the pace three wide, held aim through the turn, moved alongside the winner leaving the eighth pole but hung at the withers of the winner from there. ROMAN MAIDEN stalked the pace four wide, bid leaving the three eighths pole though leveled off in the stretch. RUNFAST showed no speed off the rail, bid into the turn but had nothing further in the stretch. ROCKPORT RADIANCE cleared most of the field for position inside, rated a slim lead off the rail, contested the turn two deep then gave way from the quarter pole. MISSTERIA was fractious and loose in the post parade then lost contact early. FASHIONETTE gave close chase the opening half mile then faded on the turn. LITTLEBITWICKED showed brief inside speed but was through after the opening quarter.
