MADISON'S WISH prompted the pace inside, drew clear on the final turn and continued gamely to the finish. FRIEND'S CASE angled wide rallying on the final turn and lacked a sufficient response. DUKE'S SHOW BIZ never menaced. HER FLING raced inside and steadily retreated. LADY OF THE HUNT was always outrun. DANCING CREEK set the pace outside for half a mile, stopped abruptly and was eased in the stretch.
