Footnotes

LOST THE SIGNAL moved boldly three wide on the turn, drifted in near the eighth pole then drew away. LIQUID DELIGHT stalked the pace outside, reached even terms in the stretch, steadied briefly near the eighth pole and was outfinished. A claim of foul by the rider of LIQUID DELIGHT against the winner was disallowed. PINK GIN was eased back early and raced far back, found her best stride too late. WISE DESIGN vied for the lead between foes then inside and yielded in the final furlong. SEEKING THE CAPE rushed up to duel inside and began retreating on the turn. GLOUCESTER STAGE vied between rivals to the turn then gave away readily.
