Footnotes

DELAWARE RIVER settled off the pace about the four path, closed toward contention approaching the final turn, took a breather through the turn, found room leaving the quarter pole, raced clear in the upper stretch and held well with steady encouragement. DISCO T rated off the pace outside, started a five wide bid into the final turn, dug in from the head of the lane and had to settle for second best. SWEET SUGAR stalked the pace about the three path, assumed control nearing the final turn, contested a short lead through the turn but leveled off in the lane. KUDU, unhurried inside, bid while eased out through the final turn and finished evenly. SERENE HARBOR, unhurried early, bid outside approaching the final turn and finished evenly. MOVIN' OUT rated off the pace toward mid track, bid from the three eighths pole, raced on even terms leaving the quarter but weakened in the stretch. ST JOHN'S GOSPEL raced close the opening turn, settled off the pace about the four path, bid into the final turn but had little further in the stretch. MR. BOXCAR rated off the pace inside, picked up the chase approaching the final turn then weakened in the lane. JUSTICEANFORTITUDE rated a clear lead after stumbling from the gate, gave chase toward the final turn then faded through the turn. SUNSHINE BERNIE was never a factor.
