Footnotes

SUZZONA stalked the pace two deep, moved alongside the pacesetter past the five sixteenths pole, took over shortly after entering the stretch, was urged clear toward the sixteenth pole and widened to the wire. INDYCAT advanced inside to rate a short lead, contested the rail past the five sixteenths pole and dueled close to the sixteenth pole before giving way to the winner. INTO WISHES closed toward contention while coming in to save ground, was shut off at the rail into the turn, eased out from the five sixteenths pole and dueled late for show. BAR FLY BLUES was shuffled back at the rail near the half mile pole, resumed the chase toward the turn, eased four wide into the lane and was closing slowly late. MISS FLEETFOOT gave chase four wide before leveling off. PURELY PERFECT gave chase about the three path, saved ground approaching the turn then leveled off in the lane. GOLD STONES was outrun.
