BALIAN, quickly clear, took position inside for the early lead, stalked the pace at the rail down the backstretch, recovered control near the seven sixteenths pole, came out entering the lane, veered sharply out midstretch then continued on gamely and just lasted. VERY ARROGANT settled off the pace inside, closed to the heels of the winner past the quarter pole, took aim in the upper stretch, dueled a close factor to the wire and just missed. CALL YOU RAISE YOU, unhurried inside, started his drive past the three eighths pole, eased out at the top of the stretch and finished best five wide. DYNAMONT settled back inside, angled five wide leaving the final turn and closed well to deep stretch in an even finish. PORTO SANTO (FR) rated off the pace about the three path, split rivals making his bid from the quarter pole, was herded inward by Blue Light Special then promptly shut off by Balian in midstretch though finished evenly the remainder. BLUE LIGHT SPECIAL, a step slow to break, moved to contention two deep on the first turn, assumed the lead into the backstretch, showed the way to the seven sixteenths pole, contested the final turn, entered the stretch five wide, ducked in a furlong away and leveled off the remainder. NATIONAL HERO, off the pace about the three path, started a three wide drive leaving the three eighths pole then weakened a furlong out. LITTLE DOVEFEATHER, MURDERINTHEFIRST and NOT FOR MONEY were all not factors. The stewards reviewed a claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of unplaced Porto Santo but found insufficient reason to make a change.
