Footnotes

ANNAPOLIS stalked the pace about the four path, took aim into the final turn, dueled from the head of the lane for control nearing the sixteenth pole and dug in determinedly to best the pacesetter. WANNABE moved to the lead three wide near the five eighths pole, rated the pace off the rail through the backstretch, saved ground nearing the final turn, dueled from the top of the stretch and while yielding with a sixteenth to go, remained a game factor to the wire. SUNSHINE BERNIE, seven wide the opening turn, settled back four wide, closed ground nearing the final turn, started a drive into the stretch and finished well to show. NO EQUIPMENT, off the pace about the three path, gave chase on the final turn and finished evenly. SELF MADE MAN, unhurried outside, improved position six wide on the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. PINE HAWK advanced along the rail through the backstretch, was roughed at the heels of Jersey Kid approaching the final turn, angled seven wide through the turn and finished evenly widest. ELDOKTORI steadied at the rail on the first turn, rated off the pace two deep on the backstretch, was boxed between horses nearing the final turn, angled in at the top of the stretch but leveled off the remainder. LUNAR PUZZLE was not a factor. JERSEY KID set the early pace off the rail the opening turn, was overcome into the backstretch, held aim to the final turn, was shuffled back at the five sixteenths pole and gave way from there.
