SHIP LINER steadied off heels entering the first turn, prompted wide and just missed. SWISS ASSET rallied wide and finished with good energy. PATCHENS ROSE BOWL made a nice run outside on final turn, then flattened out. SALEM PRINCE failed to menace. FAYGO never reached contention. SABOVEE failed to be a serious factor. CUESTA DEL NORTE raced two wide second flight then tired. PACO'S FRIEND bobbled leaving gate, saved ground in second flight, tired.
