Footnotes

THE LAST WAVE stalked the pace about the five path, bid approaching the turn, dueled to the lead at the top of the stretch and dug in under steady handling while in an outward drift to hold on well. PLURACITY chased the pace off the rail, angled to the outside past the five sixteenths pole then came back to the inside through the stretch while dueling for place. INDEPENDENCE WAR, unhurried toward the outside, saved some ground nearing the turn, lacked room through the turn, angled toward the outside from the five sixteenths pole, took aim a furlong away and was outfinished in the duel for place. WINK AT THE GIRLS alternated for the early lead inside and dueled a close factor to midstretch before weakening. WINGED HERO stalked the pace three wide, was carried to the outside leaving the five sixteenths pole then weakened in the stretch. GALLIGAN ROAD, with the pace two deep and between horses, drifted outward past the five sixteenths pole and gave way in the stretch. TWICEASBEAUTIFUL had a slim brief early lead, dropped back four wide passing the five eighths pole and faded readily.
