FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$600 each which should accompany the nomination, \$900 to pass the entry box, \$1,500 additional to start, with \$250,000 guaranteed by Philadelphia Park and an additional \$50,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Breeders' Cup eligibles only. The \$250,000 guaranteed by Philadelphia Park to be divided: \$150,000 to the winner with \$50,000 to second, \$27,500 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$7,500 to fifth. Breeders' Cup fund monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the fund. Weights: Three year olds 118 lbs; Older 122 lbs. Non-winners of an unrestricted stakes in 2007 allowed 3 lbs; of \$17,500 twice since May 1 allowed 5 lbs; of \$17,500 since May 1, 8 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered.) Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing on Tuesday, September 25, 2007.. Nominations closed Saturday, September 15, 2007 with 17. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

Footnotes

SPEECHIFYING rated a short lead inside, contested the rail through the turn, moved clear into the stretch and just lasted in an all out drive. MIRACULOUS MISS rated with the pace four wide and between horses, gave chase through the turn, closed steadily through the lane and just missed the win while taking place in deep stretch. S W ALY'SVALENTINE, with the pace two deep and between horses, held aim through the turn, lost ground at the quarter pole, finished evenly but yielded place in deep stretch. HAILIE'S GIRL rated close to the pace five wide down the backstretch, gave chase through the turn then leveled off in the drive. SHE'S FANCY FREE lunged outward leaving the gate, settled off the pace and off the rail, came out for the drive but offered no rally. GENEROSITY, shuffled back at the start, advanced to contention three wide and between horses then faded through the turn.
