NOTHING BUT FUN raced three wide while just off the pace, raced widest on the final turn and into stretch, battled gamely and was just up. YOLANDA B. TOO broke slowly, recovered quickly and was hustled up to race two wide second flight, battled between foes through the stretch and just missed. SHEBELONGSTOYOU was eased back after the start, was widest stalking the early pace, lead entering stretch and then gave way grudgingly. AMAZING BUY dueled for command two wide, weakened late. INDIAN VALE bobbled slightly at the start, was hustled to duel along the rail and tired. TOLL TAKER saved ground and stopped.
