STAKES Fitz Dixon Cotillion S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred



FOR FILLIES THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$750 each which should accompany the nomination, \$1,500 to pass the entry box, \$2,000 additional to start, with \$750,000 guaranteed. The purse to be distributed: \$7,500 to all starters with the balance of the purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Winners of a grade I race at a mile or over in 2010 to carry 2 lbs. additional. Non-winners of a graded race at a mile or over in 2010 allowed 3 lbs. of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2010, 5 lbs.; of three races at a mile or over other than maiden or claiming in 2010, 8 lbs. This race will not be divided. A field of 14 horses will be drawn with the preference given to Graded/Group stakes winners in order (I-II-III), stakes winners, then highest career earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing on Monday, September 27, 2010. Nominations closed Saturday, September 18, 2010 with 15. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey.

HAVRE DE GRACE didn't break sharply but recovered quickly and was sent up to race outside and just off the early pace while under a rating hold. HAVRE DE GRACE rallied to the lead near the stretch without need of coaxing, she was roused left handed and began to drifted out while opening a long lead with a furlong to run, her rider switched his stick to his right hand and HAVRE DE GRACE gamely lasted over BLIND LUCK.. BLIND LUCK was reserved early racing off the rail, she accelerated suddenly and rallied between rivals entering the stretch, ducked in slightly when roused right handed in mid stretch, she was then put to left handed pressure and closed determinedly, just missing.. AWESOME MARIA saved ground while just off the pace, dropped back steadily. BONNIE BLUE FLAG set the pace racing well off the rail, lost the lead entering the stretch and then dropped back steadily from that point. ABSINTHE MINDED saved ground prompting the pace, appeared to jump a shadow and fell back slightly entering the stretch, recovered and continued to raced forwardly before giving way.
