UNIVERSAL LANGUAGE made a strong run between foes after a half mile, raced wide into stretch, was put to pressure to draw clear and then was taken in hand late. AMERICAN BREW was wide and outrun early, closed for place while no threat to winner. CHERRY LADY was well placed between foes, faded in the final eighth. AGNES M. broke sharply, set the pace off the rail and then gave way. LAKE BAXTER saved ground early and failed to menace. SHEZOUTAHERE raced wide. FULFILLING steadied off heels entering the backstretch, raced just off the pace and then tired. LITTLE NANCY was wide prompting the pace and then tired.
