Footnotes

IRON CLAD PROOF, displaying major improvement in racing ability, was outrun early, split foes in the stretch and closed with a rush to post the upset win. SEVENS WILD dueled wide, shook loose and held a long lead in mid stretch, began to shorten stride and faltered. SEA OF FIRE saved ground into stretch and was too late. STAMFORD BRIDGE saved ground dueling, eased back, moved off the rail and then tired. HORRIBLE HELEN failed to menace. LIKE TO KEEP BUSY failed to threaten. MUNCHIES showed little. FIVESTARGIRL dropped back steadily. SWEEP NORTH was just off the early pace, tired. LUCKY LAST MAGIC dueled for command between foes, tired. SWEET BEGINNINGS was outside and just off early pace, tired.
