DEPUTY GENERAL reserved off the pace outside, closed gamely through the final furlong and was up late. WANNABE pursued the pacesetter in the two path, took over in the stretch but was outfinished. NORTHERN CRUISER hit the side of the gate at the start, set the pace then gave way grudgingly. LIE IN THE SAND dropped far behind then found his best stride too late. SEEYOUINTHECITY made a menacing advance inside after half a mile then flattened out. SPUNK dropped back early then passed fading rivals. PORT RENFREW was roughed up at the start and never menaced. WESTWARD GO raced far behind then passed fading rivals. RADIUM SPRINGS was within striking range early and stopped abruptly. SHARP AFFAIR gave way readily. MORAL FIBER raced very wide and gave way.
