TOP OF THE LEAGUE unhurried early, moved between horses on the far turn, angled out at the top of the stretch to gain command and proved best in the drive. THAT'S IT DOC made a run along rail into the far turn, angled out into the stretch, rallied outside. ENDEAR unhurried saving ground, gained a short advantage on the far turn, rallied late. PETIONVILLE PRIDE was never a threat. EXCELLENT ERA saved ground and failed to threaten. INFORMATIVE was hustled leaving the gate, advanced outside and weakened. WHATSERNAME three wide around the first turn, dueled for command outside and tired. BROADWAYSBLUESTAR dueled for command inside and tired. LAST WILD KISS was never a factor. SEA DRAGONESS three wide around the first turn, chased outside and tired.
