GAL ON SKIS chased the early pace and came four wide into the stretch, then got the place late. TIME FOR MUSIC pressed the early pace tried the winner on the far turn, but faded while losing the place in the final strides. KEY STORM vied for the early lead and weakened. NO MORE TWO CALL failed to menace. WESTERN DEB was off slowly while no threat. HER FLING failed to respond. SIDESTREET raced inside and tired.
