MULAHEN (GB) forced the pace inside then weakened through the stretch. DARK EQUATION raced well back throughout and never menaced. PROFESSOR MAXWELL forced the pace outside to the final turn then gave way. IRISH LADDIE bobbled over the second jump, set the pace long way then stopped.
