TWISTED HEART dropped far back outside, rallied on the turn and was up in the final sixteenth. KNEB WORTH prompted the pace outside, led briefly between calls in the stretch but was caught in the late stages. LONDON EYE raced outside, advanced on the turn, angled inside late and closed well. JIMMY THE ROOFER set a clear pace past the eighth pole then weakened. PISTOL RULES pursued the pace outside, edged closer in the stretch then yielded. COSMIC RAE dropped back early outside and never menaced. DEPUTY HONOUR dropped far behind then passed fading rivals. IMPERIAL ORDER angled inside advancing on the turn then gave way. GRAND MOTION was always outrun. FORBIDDEN CIGAR raced far back throughout. JET OUTA MY WAY was always far behind. GETAUDITDONENOW saved ground and gave way readily.
