TAP STAR stumbled and then came in leaving the gate, raced wide and had no late kick. SIR CADIAN broke slowly and saved ground. SERENDIPPER MOON saved ground setting the early pace and tired. ROUNDER was bumped around leaving the gate and then failed to menace. R GOLD BROKER was three wide and just off the pace, tired. ATLANTIC KING was bumped around leaving the gate, was hustled up between foes and then tired. GREEK GOLD was well placed between foes and then tired. LOOKIN AT OPTIONS came out leaving the gate causing crowding. SOUTH FLEET broke slowly. BULLY AROUND, wide, bolted leaving the turn.
