NAVESINK SUNSET advanced to a short lead two deep, rated the pace to the turn, edged clear from there then well handled in the stretch to maintain. GRADED BY RESULTS rated off the pace inside, made his bid approaching the quarter pole, dueled close through the stretch but hung at the winners' withers the final furlong. HOT DEPUTY showed no speed well off the rail, bid five wide nearing the quarter pole, closed steadily through the stretch and finished strong. WANDER TIME rated off the pace and off the rail, eased four wide making a bid toward the quarter pole then leveled off the final furlong. EL CAMPO showed no speed inside, bid mildly into the stretch and finished evenly. WHISKEY SEZ showed no speed about the three path, eased out leaving the quarter pole but had no rally. HONEST EXPECTATION came away sharply for a brief clear early lead, stalked the winner from the inside then faded toward the quarter pole and showed no stretch response.
