Footnotes

TITANIC WIN settled back toward the outside, saved ground approaching the turn, made a strong bid on the rail from the top of the stretch and got up the final strides. REDEFINED rated off the early pace inside, bid from the five sixteenths pole, dug in from the head of the lane, was forced out late stretch but recovered well to get the nod for place. M J'S ENCHANTEUR rated a mostly clear lead inside, was pressured from the top of the stretch, bore out in deep stretch then outfinished the final strides. SHOULDABEENACLOWN chased the pace about the three path, started angling outward from the quarter pole, lost more ground than intended leaving the turn but finished evenly widest. MATHEWLOVESTOPARTY chased the pace from the outside, saved ground about the three path on the turn then shuffled back and steadied late. BANG BANG BANG, shuffled back early, gave chase about the three path then leveled off in the lane. BLUES CLUB chased the pace from off the rail, contested between horses on the turn then weakened in the lane.
