**Footnotes**

BOLD ATTITUDE stalked the pace about the four path, bid passing the three eighths pole, reached the lead inside the quarter pole, drew off with aggressive hand urging though allowed to relax nearing the wire. JOHNNY KING broke inward to make contact with Yuri's Travels causing the rider to lose her irons, settled into stride about the three path through the backstretch, started a drive nearing the quarter pole and finished evenly to place. FIVESIXSEVEN stalked the pace off the rail, bid into the turn, had aim at the top of the stretch but leveled off the final furlong. G W IS BEST stalked the pace from the three path, rallied to the front nearing the three eighths pole then weakened from between horses in the upper stretch. RISKY DYNAMITE, unhurried early, made a mild bid in mid track through the turn then leveled off in the stretch. CHASE MY HEELS, a step slow to start, never factored. PATIENT REIGN and YURI'S TRAVELS exchanged contact at the start and never factored. CAPTAIN JEFF stalked the pace from the outside, lacked a response on the turn then weakened bearing outward in the stretch. MMSPATRICK showed brief speed to move clear for inside position but readily gave way on the turn.
