Footnotes

TUJOES, unhurried off the rail, advanced in the four path of the final turn, dug in from the top of the stretch to get up toward the sixteenth pole and was clear nearing the wire. SLOANE RANGER rated off the pace well off the rail, advanced from the three eighths pole to take over near the quarter, dug in with the advantage from the head of the lane though reluctantly yielded the final sixteenth. LAST EMPIRE, reluctant to load, settled unhurriedly off the rail, improved his position through the final turn and finished evenly to show. SWEET BERNIE, awkward at the break, advanced to the front nearing the three quarter pole, rated the lead off the rail through the backstretch, was pressured into the final turn and remained close in the upper stretch before weakening. DAPPER DEVIL, well back toward mid track, saved some ground on the final turn then leveled off in the lane. SMALLTOWNMAN and OUT IN THE REIGN were through early.
