YANKEE PILOT was outrun early, rallied near the inside then drew away quickly in the final furlong. NEW YANKEE MAN vied for the advantage inside, drew clear in the stretch but was outfinished. THE BIG STORY raced off the pace between rivals and continued well while no threat. THE MAN CAN STEP raced wide and flattened out through the stretch. CHITTLIN forced the pace outside, reached even terms on the turn then faltered. MISTER FIPS (IRE) ducked out after the start, raced wide and lacked a rally. RIDIN' HARD dropped back early and was never a factor. ZIRLANCELOT raced far back throughout. NIFTY MAMBO forced the pace between rivals then stopped abruptly and was being eased in the final furlong.
