CELTIC JOURNEY broke alertly to duel for the lead, drew away in mid-stretch and lasted. PRECIOUS JANE was outrun early between rivals; advanced wide into the stretch and closed well. FLYING SKIER stalked the pacesetters four wide then flattened out in the stretch. DESORIENTATED saved ground early, was taken up between foes at the top of the stretch then had no further response. HEAVENLY EMPRESS trailed early then closed a gap while no factor. BRING ME FORTUNE angled outside in the opening quarter mile and lacked a rally. DANICA IRL vied for the advantage inside, came out at the top of the stretch and faded. DIME BOX stumbled badly at the start, raced wide and stopped. A claim of foul by the rider of DESORIENTATED against the rider of FLYING SKIER for interference at the top of the stretch was dismissed by the stewards.
