Footnotes

ANTITRUST stalked the pace from the inside, eased to the four path through the final turn, dug in from the top of the stretch for the lead at the sixteenth pole then inched clear toward the wire. MAXXAM XPRESS stalked the pace three wide, dueled to a slim lead approaching the five sixteenths pole and dug in with the advantage to the sixteenth pole before reluctantly ceding. TICFAW, off the pace outside, started a drive toward the final turn, entered the stretch five wide and got the nod to show. REP, off the pace inside, showed no significant response on the final turn. TARGET PRACTICE reached the front five wide nearing the three quarter pole, rated the pace to the seven sixteenths, was pressured into the final turn and remained close to the upper stretch before weakening. EMPTY HANDED moved to the outside after steadying at the break and was no factor. SKIP, off the pace two deep, gave way toward the final turn.
