LUCNDASKYWITDIMNDS lunged from the gate, rated with the pace while alternating for the lead two deep down the backstretch, started her drive into the stretch and caught the winner apparent through the final yards. REAL LACE rated off the pace toward mid track, advanced to a clear lead approaching the quarter pole, appeared the winner in midstretch but flattened stride through the final yards. BEAUTIFUL RING showed no speed in mid track, improved her position widest on the turn then finished evenly. NANA'S BIRTHDAY rated close about the three path through the backstretch, gave chase approaching the turn then drifted out weakening at the quarter pole. SUM WISH was outrun. HALF MOON THURSDAY rated with the pace inside while alternating for the lead through the backstretch, continued the contest through the turn then weakened in the stretch. MAC N MAYO briefly settled off the pace before giving chase inside but was never a factor.
