Footnotes

I GOT SWAGGER stalked the pace four wide, took a slim lead at the three eighths pole, dug in from the head of the lane to edge clear inside the eighth pole then held on well under steady encouragement. DELANEY'S D'LITE rated off the pace about the four path, stayed in range through the turn, started a drive from the head of the lane and finished well though needed more. RAYBERN'S GOLD settled close outside, bid from the three eighths pole, entered the stretch six wide and finished evenly. VOYTEK stalked the pace three wide, contested the turn and dueled close in the upper stretch before weakening. LONDON EYE stalked the pace two deep, dropped back through the turn then weakened in the lane. TOUGH TURKEY was outrun. YOUNG TROUBADOR rated a short lead inside, contested the rail through the turn then weakened toward the eighth pole.
