BOLD DESPERADO was outrun early, moved up along the rail, eased out in early stretch and was along in time. CONSIDER ME was outside early and angled to the rail on the far turn, took the lead but couldn't last. STACKEMUP set the pace well off the rail, weakened slightly. SHAPEZ raced outside, bid but then flattened out. GENTLE JOURNEY was jostled leaving the gate, saved ground and tired. PROPSISTOPS came in leaving the gate, was trying to bear out badly while prompting the early pace, stopped and was being eased. DIAMOND ROCK showed nothing.
