ZOOGER was away alertly and well placed close to the pace then lacked the needed stretch response. BULL TOCCTET broke alertly and set the pace racing removed from the inside rail then faded in the drive. OLDHAM moved up wide on the far turn then lacked a further response. IL TERRAZZO prompted the pace to the far turn then weakened in the drive. SCARLET AND GOLD showed little. SURE START lacked a rally. FORT DENMARK prompted the pace to the far turn then tired.
