WILLOW GROVE vied for the lead between foes and then inside, repulsed repeated challenges in a game effort. TRINACRIA bid wide on the turn, loomed boldly in the stretch but was outfinished. INDYCAT forced the pace outside to midstretch and weakened in the final eighth. HOT ROUTE was outrun between rivals early and had only a mild response. SERRANO DEL SOL raced close up inside then gradually faltered. DEBUTANTE'S CHARM was far back early and showed some energy too late. JAKES HEART rushed up to contest the pace and began retreating on the turn.
