### Footnotes

SLICK IDEA stalked two wide, took the lead on the final turn and drew out driving. NO EQUIPMENT was four wide while just off the pace, was no match late. SOVEREIGN FUND was outrun early, passed tiring foes. NEXT MAY showed little. PROFESSOR Z raced well off the rail and failed to menace. BOOMER'S RANGER set the pace inside and tired. BORN TO CUS was three wide in top flight and then tired badly.
