OUR MARY B. rated off the pace off the rail, moved to the pacesetters' flank approaching the final turn, reached the lead nearing the five sixteenths pole and was steadily handled through the lane. VALMENI, off the pace outside, bid five wide from the three eighths pole and closed for place. DANCING MOMENT stalked the pace from the inside, bid nearing the three eighths pole, had aim at the top of the stretch then leveled off the final sixteenth. MERRY BERRY, unhurried, bid off the rail into the final turn then leveled off through the stretch. SHE'SMINENOTYOURS rated a clear lead off the rail, was pressured through the final turn then gave way from the top of the stretch. U. S. S. SEA LION lost contact after the opening quarter.
