DAN'S GINGER quickly established the lead, rated to the top of the stretch, was pressured from that point and lasted under steady encouragement. CLARE CASTLE, off the pace outside, made a five wide bid on the turn and was closing steadily late. MILITARY PIKE settled off the pace outside, came through the turn four wide, eased out at the top of the stretch and finished evenly. ONE FRENCH KISS showed no speed inside, angled out past the quarter pole and leveled off through the lane. MR. VENTURA T chased the pace two deep then gave way in the stretch. WICKED TUNE chased the pace from the outside and leveled off through the turn. UGOTTA LIKE ME gave close early chase about the three path then weakened on the turn. FREDDY BEAR chased the pace from the inside and had nothing further on the turn.
