MISTER FIPS (IRE) dueled for command just off the rail, shook loose to open a long lead mid stretch and then held on driving. DR. BALIN raced wide, fell back in mid stretch and then was coming back. SPUNK raced very wide on the turn and into stretch, closed for third but was no real threat. BULLISH NUMBERS bobbled leaving the gate and then failed to menace. THE MAN CAN STEP vied for command three wide and tired. THE BIG STORY was well placed between foes and weakened. MUTASADDY passed tiring foes. AJUSTABULL showed little. TOPHATCAT raced wide and tired. ELECTRIC BILL dueled two wide and tired. IONIC failed to menace. DOCTOR DIESEL showed little. DESPITE THE LONG GAP BETWEEN RACES, THE HORSE'S LEFT THE PADDOCK WITH 2 MINUTES TO POST CAUSING A DELAY.
