### Footnotes

SMOKIN FLO dueled for command outside, gained a clear advantage into the stretch and proved best, driving. QUILTED DOLL up close and outside, moved three wide around the turn, rallied outside into deep stretch. CHA CHA HEDY up close and between foes, made a late run along the rail. TWISTY chased outside, moved four wide around the turn and weakened in the drive. LEON'S ISLE was never a threat. MS STAR DUSTER up close and outside, moved three wide around the turn. CAVAMARIE saved ground and tired. FLEETING DISPLAY dueled for command inside and weakened. DAYS OF CLEO trailed.
