THE DEPUTY IS HOME raced close up early in the two path, moved to the front on the turn then drew away under steady urging. GRADED BY RESULTS was close up early under a strong rating hold, bid on the turn but was no match for the winner. BOOKMASTER was outrun early, angled four wide into the stretch and flattened out. CLEMENTE prompted the pace very wide then gradually retreated. GOLDEN GATOR raced far back early inside and rallied without threatening. LONCHE raced off the pace very wide and never menaced. WHO'S BLUFFING set the pace inside to the turn then gave way readily. N. J. NORQUESTOR within striking range early, stopped abruptly.
