LADY BELLE pressed the early pace and made a three wide bid on the turn to duel for the lead, then edged clear late to prove best under a drive. OUR LITTLE LUCY was well rated early on the inside, swung out four wide for the drive, finished well. ONLY LOVE set the early pace on the inside, duelled on the turn and into the stretch, faded late while besting the rest. MAY'S PRIDE was outrun early, came wide into the stretch to have a belated rally. STONESOUP passed the tiring rivals. ACK'S BEST failed to menace. LUCKY WISH was not a threat while on the inside. STORM PROSPECT chased the early pace and weakened. N SQUARE was not a factor. J. JAY was through early. LUCKY ELEVEN made a four wide middle move and stopped.
