Footnotes

LITA'S REQUEST rated back outside, advanced toward contention widest on the turn, dueled from the top of the stretch to edge clear past the eighth pole then widened under a moderate hand ride. JOLIE'S LEADER rated a slim lead well off the rail, dueled between horses from the top of the stretch and weakened the final sixteenth. LILY VANILLY, steadied briefly at the start, advanced to contention inside, contested the turn then weakened the final furlong. CASHEL CALLING chased the early pace toward the inside, drifted outward on the turn then weakened into the stretch. LIL' IODINE gave chase toward mid track and weakened the final quarter. DAMARISCOTTA chased the pace outside, was carried out leaving the quarter pole and gave way into the lane. LAURA K chased the pace in mid track, bore out nearing the quarter pole and gave way in the lane.
