SELF DEALIN' MAN trailed early, advanced in the two path on the turn, awaited room briefly at the quarter pole, split rivals, offered a strong surge and was clear late. TALE OF THE COURT vied for the advantage inside, drifted out in the final furlong crowding a rival then gave way grudgingly. FIRST NITE saved ground throughout and closed well through the stretch. TOCCT'S CHARM prompted the pace three wide between foes, steadied and altered course in the final furlong and was outfinished. KINSMAN REDEEMER forced the pace in the two path then gradually weakened. HAILTOTHEREDSKINS prompted the pace four wide then came up empty in the stretch. RAYNICK'S TOKEN raced outside and was always outrun. JUSTICE COWBOY raced outside and stopped abruptly. Following an objection by the rider of TOCCT'S CHARM, TALE OF THE COURT was disqualified from second and placed fourth by the stewards.
